Benjamin Harjo won second place for his pen/ink drawing, *The Age of Sacrifice*.



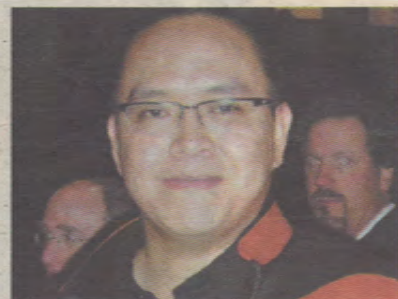
Frank Fowler, Jr., received first place for his painting, *Winter Ye! Be Chey Dance*.
